<sup>1</sup>Geometric Average: This weighted calculation uses each portfolio holding's market cap in a way designed to not skew the effect of very large or small holdings; instead, it aims to better identify the portfolio's center, which Royce believes offers a more accurate measure of average market cap than a simple mean or median.

<sup>2</sup>Harmonic Average: This weighted calculation evaluates a portfolio as if it were a single stock and measures it overall. It compares the total market value of the portfolio to the portfolio's share in the earnings of its underlying stocks.

The **Price-Earnings**, or P/E, ratio is calculated by dividing a company's share price by its trailing 12-month earnings-per-share (EPS). The Fund's P/E ratio calculation excludes companies with zero or negative earnings (14% of portfolio holdings as of 06/30/20). The Price-to-Book, or P/B, Ratio is calculated by dividing a company's share price by its book value per share.

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Net leverage is the percentage, in excess of 100 %, of the total value of equity type investments, divided by net assets.
